Unionville vineyards in Ringoes is owned by a group of local landowners, committed to growing the finest grape stock and preserving the craft of artisan winemaking. The first grape vines were planted in 1982 and winemaking started in 1987. The property is part of New Jersey's Farmland Preservation Program in one of the state's most historic agricultural areas. Unionville's winemaker feels that the fruit being grown is of a very high quality. As a result, the quality and the reputation of New Jersey wines continues to increase.
